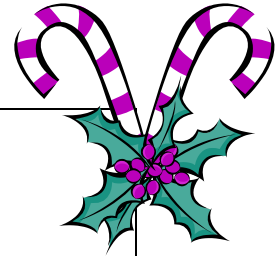

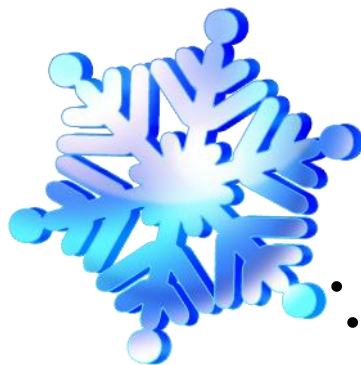

As you may have noticed, a lot has been changing on Aberdeen Avenue. What was once farmland has transformed over the last ten months and will soon be called home by many Jordan residents. We are excited to finish the construction process and move forward serving the senior community of Jordan. We are excited to become part of the Jordan business community.

Oak Terrace Senior Community of Jordan will consist of 42 assisted and senior independent apartments as well as a special memory care unit designed specifically for individuals suffering from dementia. Every resident will have access to a 24-hour emergency call system, daily reassurance checks, social and spiritual activities, and many other services to ensure the health and quality of life of each resident.

Independent and Assisted residents will enjoy an in house internet lounge, beauty salon, theater, private dining room, the “Minnesota Room” finished with natural Minnesota stone and wood, and three other large activity rooms.

Our Memory Care community (referred to as Autumn Lane) consists of single and double rooms. Autumn Lane is a comfortable and secure environment with its own activity areas and an emphasis on resident and staff interaction.

Taking advantage of new technology, Oak Terrace Senior Community of Jordan will be a wireless community enabling the use of motion detectors in special needs cases.
