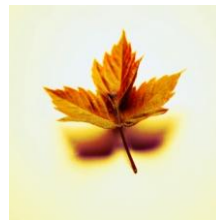
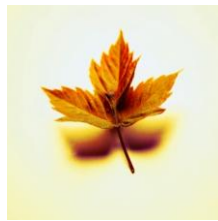

## **Stamp Card**

The Chamber will be kicking off its new Stamp card on November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010.

We will be distributing the stamp card via the Jordan Independent, and we will have some to distribute at local businesses. The purpose of the stamp card is to have everyone in Jordan visit local businesses, businesses that are currently Chamber Members. We will be distributing stamps to all participating chamber businesses. Here is how it works:

Customers will receive a stamp card with the participating Chamber Member Businesses listed on it.

Customers will receive one stamp per transaction when they visit your business. Customers will need to receive ten stamps to fill their stamp cards to turn in for a weekly drawing of \$50.00 in Jordan Dollars. Drawings will be held Fridays from November 1<sup>st</sup> to December 31<sup>st</sup>. Locations to turn in filled stamp cards to be determined.

Customers can turn in as many filled cards as they want for a chance to win. All filled stamp cards will be entered for a \$100.00 Jordan Dollars drawing at Thanksgiving, and a \$250.00 Jordan Dollars drawing at Christmas.
